Course Outline

Class Description

This class will look at the calling that Jesus places upon the life of every believer, and what it means to truly follow Christ. Students will spend time looking at the simple commands of Christ, and what they truly mean. Students will spend time examine the love of God, and the biblical way of thinking. Pastor Drew will draw from years of ministry experience and challenge the students with an uncompromising view of the scriptures that is both challenging and extremely refreshing.

Objectives

1. That each student would understand the call of Christ, and decide to follow him unconditionally.
2. To see minds renewed and transformed by the Word of God.
3. That students would be transformed into the image of Christ.

Class Requirements

1. Attendance - Each student needs to watch all videos and participate in all video meetings.
2. Daily Homework - Each student needs to complete the daily homework assigned.
3. Final Project - A 3-5 page paper as explained below.
4. (RECOMMENDED - Read "True Discipleship" by William MacDonald

Day	Homework
Day #1	Read all the versos given in the outline "The Calling of Christ" Spend time prayer asking God to make these truths a reality in your life. Read outline on love.
Day #2	Read and pray over Romans 5:5 and Ephesians 3:17-19. Read Matthew chapters 5-7. Read John 15:20 and 17:14. Read Acts 14:22 and Ephesians 3:14-19. Read page 1 of outline on the Mind
Day #3	Read page 2 of the outline on the mind.
Day #4	Read 1 John 2:15-19 and identify the temptations of the world. Then read Genesis 3:6, Matthew 4:1-11, and Luke 12:22-34. Identify the three temptations in each section.
Day 5	Read 1 Samuel 10-29 (yes, 20 chapters) Notice the progression of Saul's life, and how a thought became a destiny. Reread the outline on the mind and all the verses. Pray that they would become real in your life.
Final Project	Write a 3-5 page paper on a thought in your life that did not come from God. Explain how it has become a habit, and how God has confronted you through this class. Explain biblically why you recognize that way of thinking as sin. Give a detailed plan how you plan to overcome the problem. THIS MUST BE BIBLICAL AND SHOULD COME FROM CLASS TEACHING.
